#	TEMPORARY WALL SOLUTIONS	
1	Use removable wallpaper or decals for an accent wall	
2	Hang art or mirrors with Command strips or hooks

4	Use adhesive mounting tape or Velcro strips for lightweight decor	
5	Create a gallery wall with removable frames and art	

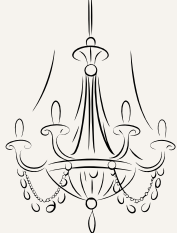


#	FURNITURE THAT WORKS DOUBLE DUTY

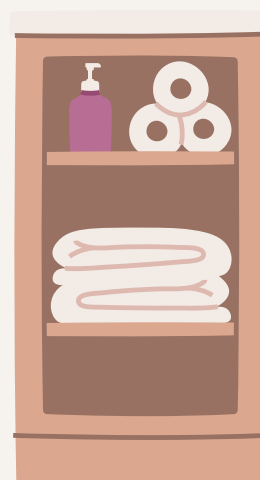

#	GREENERY AND PLANTS	
1	Add low-maintenance plants like snake plants or pothos	
2	Use hanging planters or wall-mounted shelves for greenery	
3	Try faux plants for a no-fuss option

5	Use decorative planters to add style to your space	

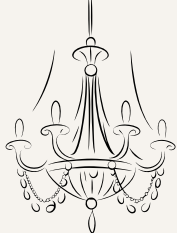


#	DECORATING WITHOUT NAILS	
1	Use Command hooks for hanging lightweight decor	
2	Try Velcro strips or adhesive mounting tape for frames and mirrors	
3	Lean large mirrors or art against the wall for a stylish look	
4	Use over-the-door organizers for shoes, accessories, or pantry items	
5	Hang curtains with tension rods instead of drilling holes	

#	KITCHEN AND BATHROOM UPGRADES	
1	Use peel-and-stick backsplashes in the kitchen	
2	Add removable adhesive hooks for towels or utensils	
3	Organize with over-the-door storage solutions	
4	Use drawer liners to protect surfaces and add color	
5	Add a shower caddy or shelf for extra bathroom storage

#	SEASONAL DECOR SWAPS	
1	Switch out throw pillows and blankets for seasonal colors	
2	Add seasonal decor like wreaths or table centerpieces	
3	Store off-season items in labeled bins for easy access	
4	Use removable window clings for festive decor	
5	Add a seasonal doormat for a welcoming touch	



#	ADDING PERSONALITY WITH TEXTILES	
1	Layer throw pillows and blankets for a cozy vibe	
2	Hang curtains high and wide to make windows feel larger	
3	Add an area rug to define your space and add warmth	
4	Use a slipcover to update your sofa or chairs	
5	Drape a cozy throw over your bed or couch	



#	MOVING-PROOF TIPS	
1	Document your space with before-and-after photos	
2	Keep all original fixtures and hardware for easy re-installation	
3	Use non-permanent solutions that are easy to remove	
4	Label boxes and bins for easy unpacking	
5	Take inventory of your decor to plan for your next space	



#	STYLING SHELVES AND SURFACES	
1	Use trays or baskets to corral clutter	
2	Display books, candles, and trinkets for personality	
3	Add a few meaningful decor items (e.g., photos, travel souvenirs)	
4	Use bookends to keep shelves tidy and stylish	
5	Add a small vase or bowl for keys and small items	

Bonus Tips Section:

PRO TIP #1



- Use removable adhesive putty to secure small decor items like picture frames or vases

PRO TIP #2



- Layer rugs for extra texture and warmth—just make sure they're non-slip!

PRO TIP #3



- Create a gallery wall using Command strips for a personalized, renter-friendly look

PRO TIP #4



- Use furniture sliders to protect floors and make rearranging easier

PRO TIP #5



- Add a statement piece (like a bold lamp or artwork) to anchor your space

PRO TIP #6



- Use tension rods to hang curtains, create storage solutions, or even organize cleaning supplies under the sink—no drilling required!
